Professional Experience

During his tenure at BBK, Tim has managed numerous situations on behalf of OEM clients involving troubled Tier 1 suppliers. His experiences there have included the successful transition of a major portion of a \$100 million stamping company to new ownership, the restructuring and refinancing of an injection molding company, and the recapitalization of a major foam supplier. He has also lead numerous supply risk management projects for these clients.

Tim has developed and implemented restructuring and liquidation plans in the manufacturing, distribution, retail, and restaurant industries. He has also advised institutional clients on the achievability of restructuring plans advanced by debtor clients. He directed the divestiture of \$25 million of retail property as part of a sale in bankruptcy of a \$400 million restaurant chain and was instrumental in the restructure of the operations of a distributor that allowed a return to operating profitability.

Prior to joining BBK, Tim was the Chief Commercial Credit Officer for Standard Federal Bank, a subsidiary of ABN AMRO (now Bank of America). There he was responsible for the development of all aspects of the Bank's credit function including credit review and management, credit approval, credit analyst recruiting and training, and the formation and oversight of the loan workout group.

His career in banking also includes nine years at NBD Bank (now JP Morgan Chase), including three years as an officer in the Bank's workout group.

Tim is also the Vice Chairman of the Board of Karmanos Cancer Hospital and sits on both the Executive and Finance Committees of Karmanos Cancer Institute. He has assisted management in addressing the capital structure of the Hospital and Institute.
